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



II. Are there Dispensations?


Eph 1: 20 ... He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

- Cf. Math 12:32; Mark 10:30; Luk 18:30
aion = age, world, eternity = hebr. *'olam*
- Differentiation between 2 ages.
- Like in the Rabbinical Literature:
 - *ha'olam hazeh*: *this age*
 - *ha'olam haba'*: the coming age (= Messianic Kingdom)



II. Are there Dispensations?

Eph 1: ... 10 that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth - in Him.


- **Explanatory commentary:** During the Millenium Christ will rule over the whole earth. This kingdom is called here "The dispensation of the fullness of time".
 - *oikonomia* = household, house law, stewardship, dispensation, lat. "dispensatio"
- „Dispensationalism“ = Dividing of the Biblical timeline according to different ages /dispensations

II. Are there Dispensations?

Col 1: ... 26 the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints.




Cf. Rom 16:25; 1Cor 10:11; 2Tim 1:9; Hebr 9:26

- These verses speak about **ages** in the plural.
- Plural = at least **2**!
- Eph 1:21 and Col 1:26 speak about at least **4** ages!

III. Covenants and Dispensations

Jeremiah 31: 31 " Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah -- 32 "not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day *that* I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD.

- **Explanation:** The Millennium – “the Coming Age” – will begin with a new covenant with Israel. This covenant stays in contrast to the covenant at Sinai. → Contrast of 2 covenants and 2 dispensations
- **Question:** Are there still other covenants of God?

- Deadly conflict between Jacob and Esau → Jacob had to flee.
- Laban betrays Jacob.
- Jacob's marriages with 4 women
- Problems in the family of Jacob: 10 brothers against Joseph
- Strives between the 4 women.
- Dina defiled
- Joseph sold into slavery
- The 10 sons betray their father Jacob.
- Ruben's incest
- Juda's fall into whoredom with Tamar
- God's discipline: famine
- By God's grace: survival in Egypt

The 6th Dispensation

- **Dan 1: 1 In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it. 2 And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, ...**
- 606: Juda becomes a satellite state / vassal state of Babylonia.



The 6th Dispensation

- 2Chr 36: **13 And he also rebelled against King Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear an oath by God; ...**
- 606: Judah becomes a satellite state / vassal state of Babylonia.
- 597: Nebuchadnezzar makes a covenant with Zedekiah, which God calls „my covenant (Ez 17; 2Kings 24:14-16; 2Chr 36:10-13). → Judah accepts Babylon's power.

The 6th Dispensation

Ez 17: 12 ... Indeed the king of Babylon went to Jerusalem and took its king and princes, and led them with him to Babylon. 13 'And he took the king's offspring [Zedekiah], made a covenant with him, and put him under oath. He also took away the mighty of the land, 14 'that the kingdom might be brought low and not lift itself up, but that by keeping his covenant it might stand. 15 'But he rebelled against him by sending his ambassadors to Egypt, that they might give him horses and many people. Will he prosper? Will he who does such things escape? Can he break a covenant and still be delivered? 16 'As I live,' says the Lord GOD, 'surely in the place where the king dwells who made him king, whose oath he despised and whose covenant he broke -- with him in the midst of Babylon he shall die.

The 6th Dispensation

Ez 17: 17 'Nor will Pharaoh with his mighty army and great company do anything in the war, when they heap up a siege mound and build a wall to cut off many persons. 18 'Since he despised the oath by breaking the covenant, and in fact gave his hand and still did all these things, he shall not escape.' " 19 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "As I live, surely My oath which he despised, and My covenant which he broke, I will recompense on his own head. 20 "I will spread My net over him, and he shall be taken in My snare. I will bring him to Babylon and try him there for the treason which he committed against Me. 21 "All his fugitives with all his troops shall fall by the sword, and those who remain shall be scattered to every wind; and you shall know that I, the LORD, have spoken."

The 6th Dispensation

Dan 9: 23 ... therefore consider the matter, and understand the vision: 24 Seventy weeks [of years] are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

1 week of years = 7 years → 70 weeks of years = 490 years

Daniel's Prophecy concerning the 70 Weeks of Years

The 6th Dispensation

Dan 9: **25 Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, there shall be seven weeks [of years] and sixty-two weeks [of years]; ...**
